The scheduling process is extremely complicated because of:

1. the vast distances between some teams,
2. the relative balance/imbalance between East and West participating towns,
3. the need to provide variety of competition, and
- 4 an equal number of home and away games.

**Kevin Mason will take a crack at drafting a high school schedule while limiting rush hour travel times to less than 1 hour each way.**

**All Star Games:** present plans call for Newington to host this year's games.  
**Kevin Mason will ascertain that town's fees for doing so.**

**All Star Games:** it was noted there has been significant inconsistency in the number of All Star slots allotted to each team. In part this is a product of the number of teams in each Division. **At our June 1 meeting, when we know the precise number of teams in each Division, at that time we will determine how many slots each team will receive.**

A member coach raised the question of allowing Middle School Division players to "play up" to avoid forfeits during the season.

**Agreed: such an exception is contra to our policy of not weakening the competitive level of our upper Divisions by permitting younger players.**  
A better approach to avoiding forfeits is rigorous management of Player Availability Schedules and utilization of the At Large Player Pool.
